PRECINCT OFFICERS, DELEGATES, AND ALTERNATES

It all starts in your precinct with organizing your neighbors, turning them out to vote, and volunteering with your Republican organizations, starting with Crow Wing County Republicans. Precinct officers are elected for a two (2) year term. Responsibilities are:

- represent the Republican Party to the voters in your Precinct.
- support Candidates and the Party financially.
- recruit volunteers and assist your BPOU and candidates by helping with fundraising events, getout-the-vote phoning, door knocking, volunteer recruitment, sign placement, and any other volunteer activities.
- fill your Precinct delegation for BPOU conventions. If any Delegates are not attending, recruit Alternates to attend and fill missing Delegate seats.

Delegates and alternates are also elected for a two (2) year term. Responsibilities of a delegate or alternate are:

- work with Precinct and BPOU officers to elect endorsed Republican candidates.
- attend ALL conventions and educate yourself on the issues you will be voting on.
- recruit an alternate to take your place if you are unable to attend any convention.
- Support your BPOU, candidates, and the Party financially.
- Volunteer to help at conventions.
- assist candidates and your BPOU with fundraising events, get-out-the-vote phoning, door knocking, volunteer recruitment, sign placement, and any other volunteer activities including parades, tent events, county and state fair, and information distribution.
