Nearly unanimous support for veterans bill

On Thursday we passed a veterans budget bill on nearly a unanimous vote to show our support for current military personnel and veterans in Minnesota.

Supporting Minnesota's veterans and military members goes beyond partisanship. Our brave service members put their lives on the line to protect our freedoms, and we must support them when they return home. They do so because they love their country and strive to make the world a better place, and it is the responsibility of all elected officials to recognize their commitment and service.

Bill highlights:

- * Increase funding and eligibility for bonuses for members who served during the post-9/11 military era
- * A one-time appropriation to honor service members on the fiftieth anniversary of the Vietnam War
- * Funding for a Minnesota Military & Veterans Museum at Camp Ripley
- * Continued funding for the three new veteran homes in Bemidji, Montevideo and Preston, which the Legislature originally funded in 2018
- * Provide enlistment and retention bonuses to incentivize retention and recruitment
- * Fund grants for veteran participation in Camp Bliss a program where eligible veterans would receive therapy, transportation, and activities specific to veterans and their family or caretakers
